Subject: CARTER CARBURETOR WARRANTY

The Carter Carburetor Warranty covers any defective material or workmanship developing within 4,000 miles or 90 days, whichever occurs first. Certain Carter service outlets are authorized to handle warranty adjustments with Packard Dealers. These can be located in the Classified Section of your telephone book listed under Carter's registered trademark. Only the Carter Centrals, Zone Distributors, Service Distributors and Service Stations handle warranty adjustments. General Cabinet Stations and Jobbers are also listed, but should not be contacted for warranty work.

If any defect occurs within the Carter Carburetor Warranty of 90 days or 4,000 miles whichever occurs first, Packard Dealers should remove carburetors and take them to the nearest Carter warranty station for warranty service. Carter units or parts should not be returned to the Carter Carburetor Corporation, St. Louis nor to the Packard Motor Car Company, Detroit.

Please keep in mind that the Carter Carburetor Warranty covers defective material or workmanship only and that neither Packard nor Carter are responsible for the accumulation of dirt, gum, water and other foreign matter in the carburetor. Correction of such conditions is not an expense subject to adjustment under the warranty.
